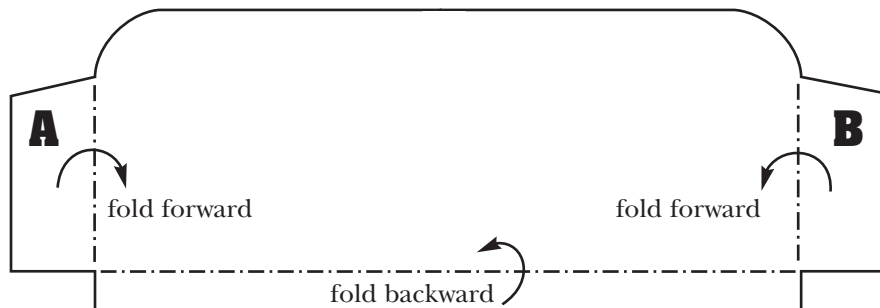
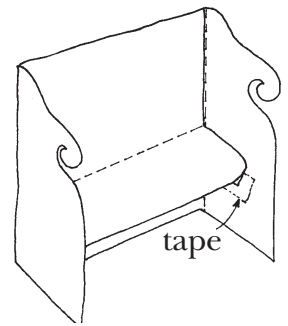
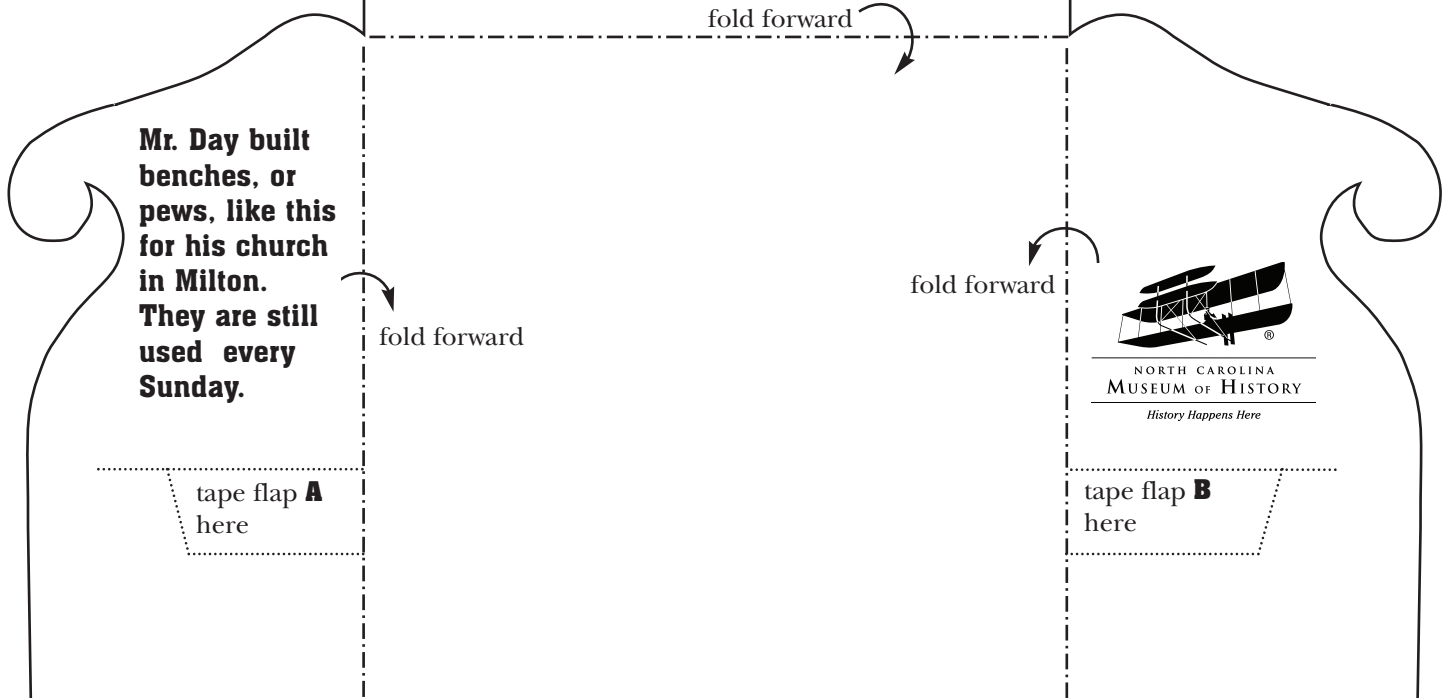


make a Thomas Day bench
